# Background

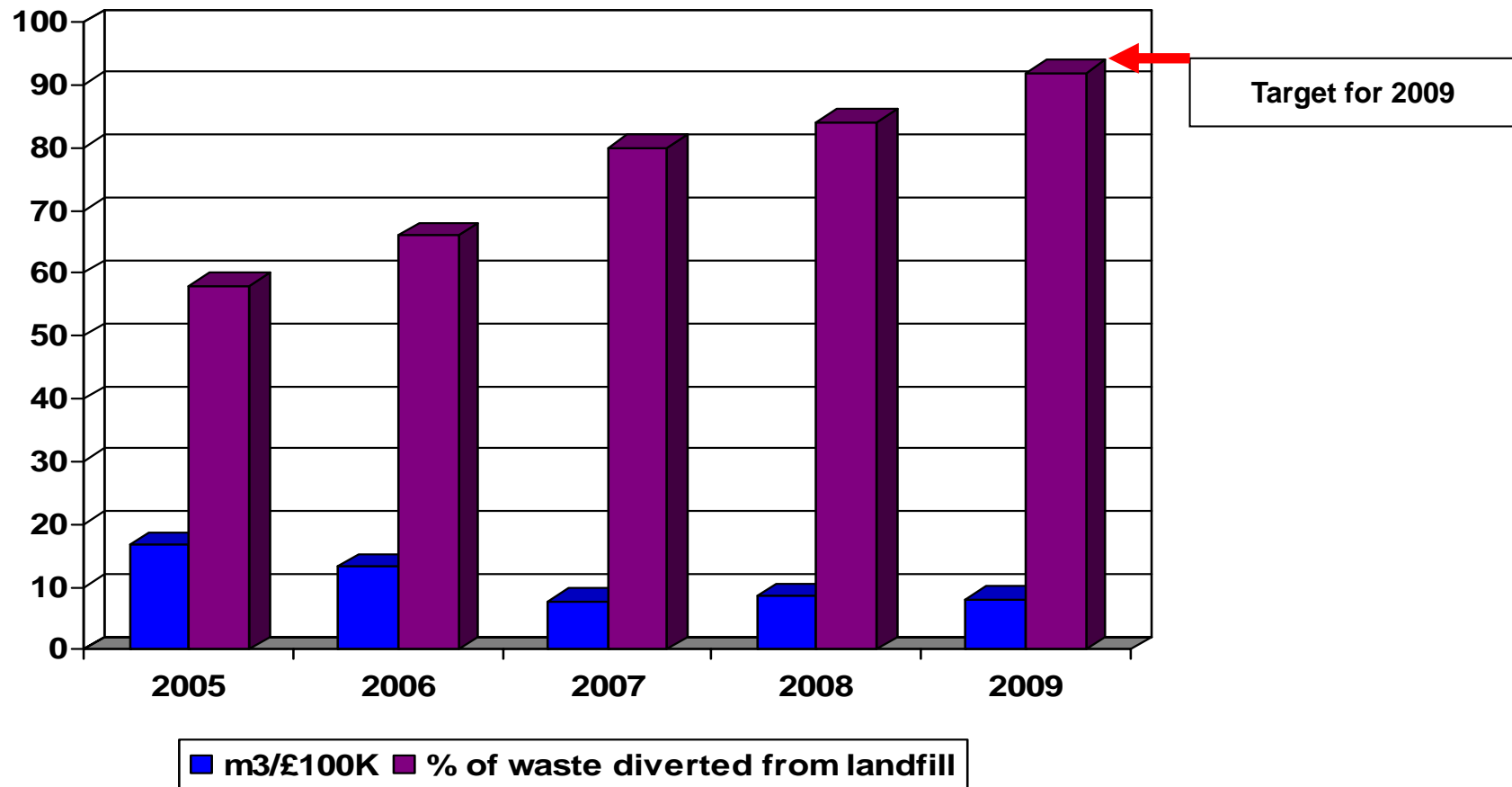
- Construction produces over 100 million tonnes of waste
- Industry creates 3 times as much waste as domestic households
- Historically, limited action being taken by the industry to reduce, reuse, recycle
- Over 50% of waste was being sent to landfill
- Wates produced over 70,000 tonnes of waste and cost the business over £4 m pa

# Target Zero...The Background

- Launched 2006
- Call for Action
- Commitment to eliminating non hazardous waste from landfill by 2010
- Good progress made
- Whole strategy is based on **Collaboration**
- Committed to WRAP Halving Waste to Landfill

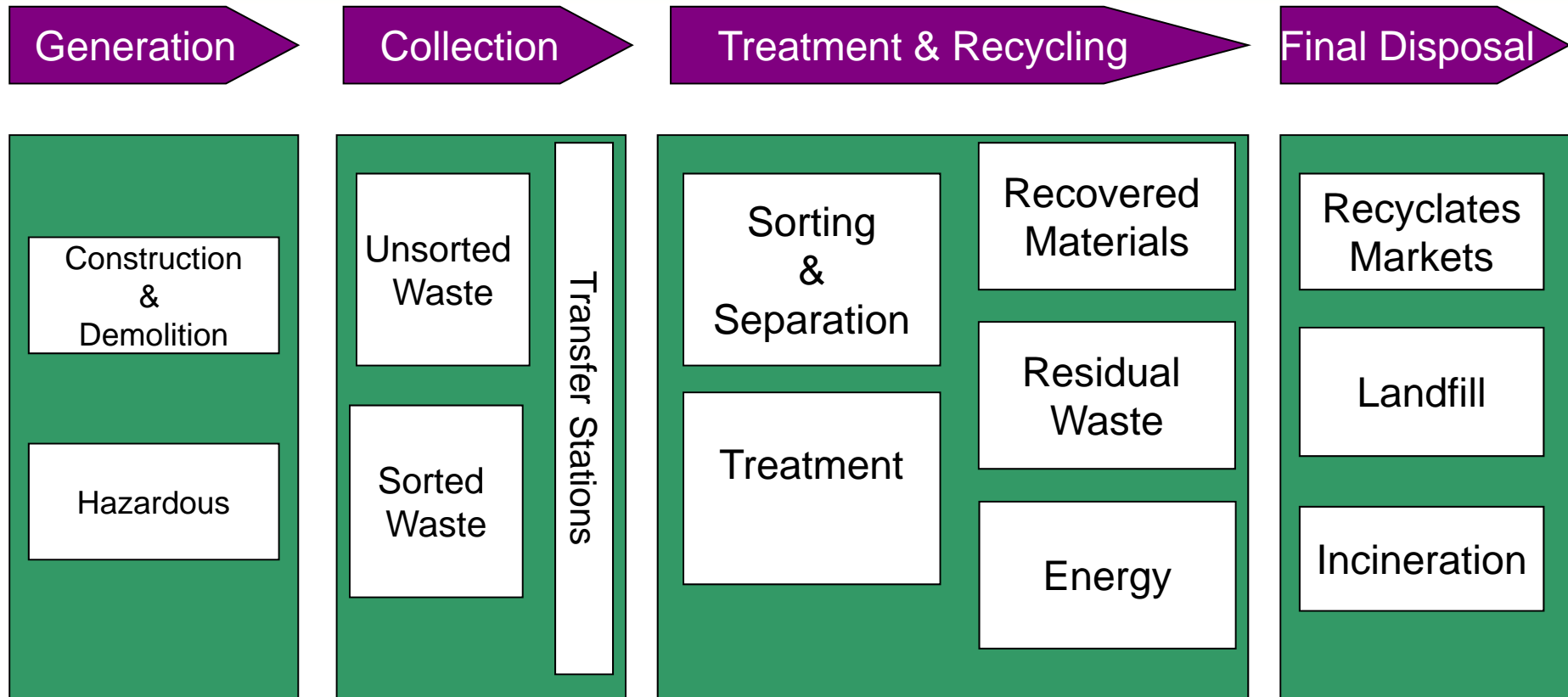
# Measuring & Reporting

- Annual Report / Progress Report

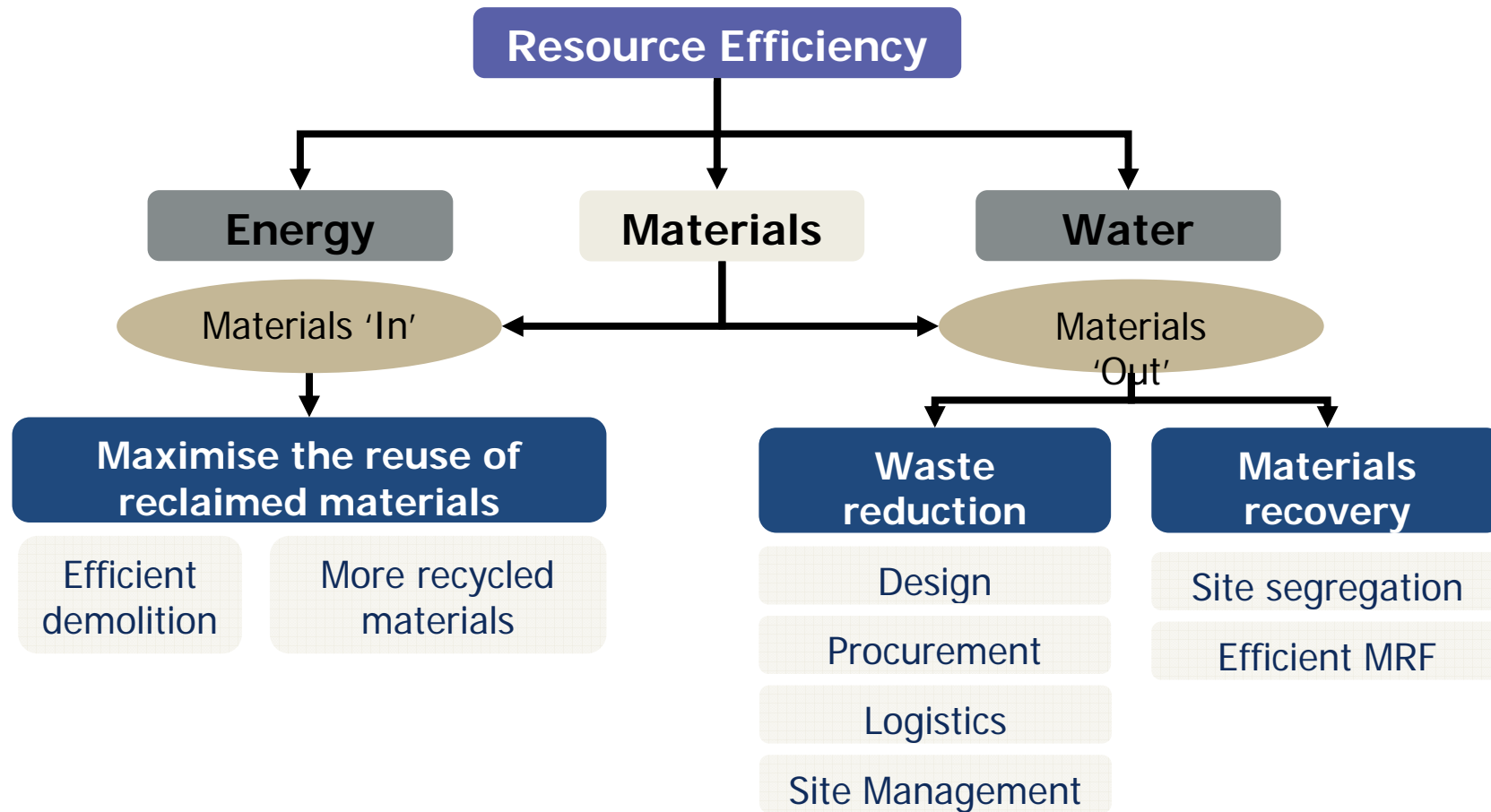
